



## THIS IS A CALL FOR INTERESTED PALM BEACH SHORES RESIDENTS TO FILL A VACANT SEAT ON THE TOWN COMMISSION

During the November 9, 2020, Town Commission Workshop, Commissioner Tom Mills resigned from the Town Commission effective immediately. As a result, there is a vacancy on the Town Commission. The Town's Charter provides for the filling of vacancies as follows:

If there shall be a vacancy in any elective office ... the town commission shall, by resolution, fill such vacancy by the appointment of a suitable person to hold such office for the unexpired term and until his or her successor shall be elected and qualified ...

The unexpired term of the seat vacated by Mr. Mills ends in conjunction with the March 2022 municipal election.

You must be a citizen of the United States, a qualified voter in Palm Beach County, and a current resident of the Town of Palm Beach Shores to be considered.

If you are qualified as stated above, and interested in being considered for appointment to fill this vacancy, please submit a resume and a letter of interest to the Town Commission explaining your background and any experience that may be relevant to this appointment.

The letter and resume must be received via mail, hand delivery, or email by the Town Clerk, Evyonne Browning, no later than close of business (4:30 pm) on November 20, 2020.
