

## Straw Poll Information

This is your opportunity as a property owner to vote on whether the Town should pursue the project and develop a detailed implementation and financing plan:



- This process was designed by the Undergrounding Resident Workgroup consisting of Elizabeth Kuechenmeister, Doug McDowell, Frank McNeil and Mayor Myra Koutzen. The process has been approved by the Town Commission and Town Attorney.
- Every aspect was designed to include as many property owners in the decision as possible and to ensure that the results fairly represent the voice of the residents.
- Only Property Owners may vote – not renters or timeshares.
- Each property in town (except timeshares) will have ONE vote. Multiple residents at an address will have to decide among themselves how they will vote. Each condominium unit is a separate property and therefore will have a vote.
- If multiple votes are received for a property, the ballot with the earliest postmark will be counted.
- The list of properties was obtained from the Palm Beach County Property Appraiser.
- Voting packages will be mailed on Wednesday, June 29, 2016 to the mailing address listed with the Property Appraiser or, if a forwarding address is listed with the USPS, sent directly to the forwarded address. Residents can check the mailing address on file at **PBCGOV.com/PAPA**
- Ballots must be marked with the property address to be valid. This is to eliminate duplicate votes. Ballots will be retained for public scrutiny as determined by Florida law.
- A simple majority of valid votes received will determine.

- Ballots should NOT be returned to Town Hall. Ballots must be received by **5:00 pm, Friday, August 5, 2016** at the above address to be valid.
- Fax and Email ballots **will not** be accepted.
- Ballots will be counted at a public meeting on a date to be announced. Ballots will be counted by the Town Auditor (Terry Morton of Nowlan, Holt & Miner), Town Attorney (Keith Davis) and Town Clerk (Evyonne Browning.)
- Results will be announced to the Commission and residents.
