## Vacant Commission Seats

Effective December 27, 2023, at noon, Commissioner Mark Ward resigned from his Commission Seat.

Effective December 29, 2023, at 10:00 a.m., Commissioner Brian Tyler resigned from his Commission Seat.

Both Commissioners resigned citing Senate Bill 774 (also known as the Form 6 disclosure) that passed and was signed by the Governor, effective January 1, 2024, as the reason for their resignations.

On January 8, 2024, at 7:00 p.m., the Town Commission will hold a Special Commission Meeting to appoint a Palm Beach Shores resident to the recently vacated seat of Commissioner Mark Ward to serve the remainder of the term for that seat which will expire in March of 2025. With only two Commission meetings remaining before the recently vacated seat of Commissioner Tyler expires, that seat will remain vacant until the March 2024 election. The Qualifying Period for that seat was November 7, 2023, through November 28, 2023, and is now closed.
